

What's Happening in Arcadia High School's Parking Lot on El Monte Avenue?

Three rows of temporary housing have been moved into place in part of the parking lot on the west side of Arcadia High School. The buildings will house classrooms and the high school administrative offices while Measure I bond facilities construction work takes place. The first students moved in to the temporary buildings this week as the first steps are taken to prepare for the new Science Center on Duarte Road. The AHS administrative offices on Campus Drive will move to the temporary buildings by the end of the school year to make way for the new Student Service Center. Demolition is expected to begin by early summer.
